Malaysia ranks 48th by the World Rugby Organisation and it is the most popular sport among top schools in Malaysia. In fact, many primary and secondary schools across the country have started establishing rugby clubs.

In addition to sponsoring the Merdeka Midnight Rugby tournament, CGC is also displaying its giant Jalur Gemilang flag in conjunction with the 62nd National Independence Day and Malaysia Day for the fifth consecutive year. The 91ft by 36ft flag is visible until the end of September 2019 to commuters boarding the LRT train from Subang Jaya to Kuala Lumpur as well as pedestrians and motorists approaching Bangunan CGC, the 16-story Headquarters building situated at Kelana Business Centre, Petaling Jaya.
